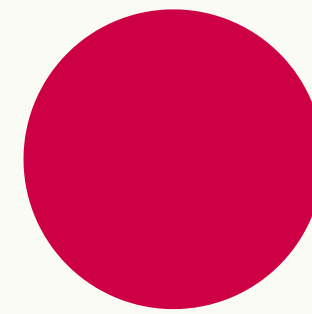

PASS helps us determine underlying cognitive processing issues that may be responsible difficulties the child is demonstrating so we can make recommendations for targeted intervention for the child.





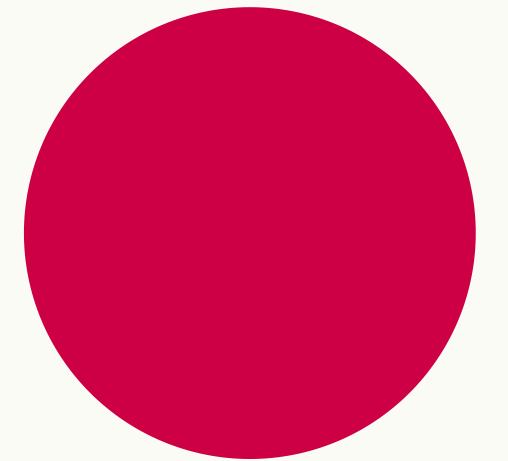
# AREAS ASSESSED

## *Academic skills include:*

- *Reading (phonetic skills, sight vocabulary, reading comprehension)*
- *Spelling*
- *Writing*
- *Mathematics (basic numerical operations, mathematical reasoning)*
- *Academic fluency (speed of reading, writing, calculating)*
- *Listening comprehension*
- *oral expressive skills*

## *Psychological aspects include:*

- *Intelligence*
- *Language skills*
- *Memory*
- *Verbal and visual learning*
- *Attention / concentration*
- *Eye - hand coordination for paper - and - pencil tasks*
- *Planning ability*
- *Time management, organizational skills, flexibility, adaptability, (executive functioning)*



# THE PROCESS

## DATA TO ACTION

### *Intake Interview*

This takes the form of structured interview with the child's parents and teachers using questionnaires and direct interviewing.

### *Direct Testing*

The child is brought to our facility on the day of the test. Test activities include written and oral components as well as physical activities

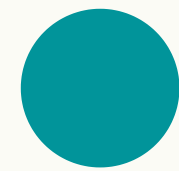
### *Post Assessment Brief*

A post assessment discussion with our multidisciplinary team to share findings and possible recommendations.

### *Written Report*

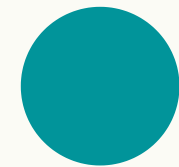
A comprehensive written report that is easy to understand by parents and school support teams is sent within 10 working days of the assessment.

# POSSIBLE DIFFICULTIES THE PASS MAY UNVEIL?



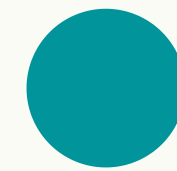
## ADHD

Attention Deficit & Hyperactivity Disorder is a common form of learning difficulty that can negatively impact learning outcomes.



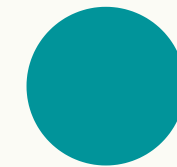
## DYSGRAPHIA

Dysgraphia is a neurological difference that impairs the child's ability to write. Written work is always inappropriately sized and spaced letters with wrong or misspelled words, despite thorough instruction.



## DYSLEXIA

This is a language based neurological difference that impacts the child's ability to recognize letters and sounds and, text comprehension during reading.



## DYSCALCULIA

This is a learning difficulty that impairs the child's ability to learn number-related concepts, perform accurate math calculations, reason and problem solve, and perform other basic math skills.

*Early identification and remediation is effective and provides the best possible outcomes when initiated between the ages of 5 to 8 years old.*
